Senator Mike Oliverio represents the 13th Senatorial District, which includes portions of Monongalia and Marion counties. He was born in Fairmont and went on to earn his bachelor's and master's degrees in business administration from West Virginia University. During his time at our state's flagship university, Senator Oliverio had the honor of serving as Student Body President during the 1985-86 academic year. He has also proudly served our country as a Captain in the United States Army.

His career in public service with the West Virginia Legislature began in 1992 with his election to the House of Delegates. Two years later, he was elected to the West Virginia Senate and served four consecutive terms, during which he served as Chairman of the Small Business Committee, Vice Chairman of the Economic Development Committee, Chairman of the Labor Committee, and Vice Chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary.

In 2022, Senator Oliverio again was elected to the Senate and began serving his fifth term in January 2023. He currently serves as Vice Chairman of the Banking and Insurance Committee and Chairman of the Interim Committee on Interstate Cooperation. Additionally, he has served as Chairman of the Governor's Committee on Crime, Delinquency and Corrections and as a member of the Family Protection Services Board.

Senator Oliverio currently resides in Morgantown and is a financial advisor. He's active as a volunteer and board member with several community organizations.
